These Supplementary Regulations can only be used for Social Karting activities at Affiliated Clubs where State and/or Federal Government mass gathering restrictions DO NOT prohibit the conduct of motor racing during the COVID-19 Pandemic Emergency.

2. ADMINISTRATION

1.	Only a member of a Club in the State issuing the Organising Permit is permitted to participate in the Activity.
2.	The Club must maintain a register of all persons who enter the Circuit for the activity.
3.	The Age Divisions offered must be in accordance with the <i>Karting Australia Appendix 1 – Kart Fun Sessions.</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cadet 9, Cadet 12 and 4SS Cadet Drivers are permitted on a Track at the same time. • Junior Drivers are not permitted on the Track with any other age division. • Senior Drivers are not permitted on the Track with any other age division.
4.	PRE-ENTRY
4.1.	The number of positions in the Activity is strictly limited by Government Directions/orders. Accordingly, bookings are essential and are accepted strictly on a 'first come first served' basis. The club will have sole rights to change bookings in order to give all members a fair chance of having access to the sessions at the club's discretion. There will be NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED ON THE DAY.
4.2.	Payment of the Entry Fee can only be made by using Credit Card through the Karting Australia CMS
5.	Entry Fee: \$40.00 per person (members of NKRC) and \$60.00 per person (non-members of NKRC) – Entries Close midnight Friday 17 th July, 2020.
5.1.	The Entry Fee for each driver at this activity includes GST.

3. SPECIFIC COVID-19 RESTRICTION AND MITIGATION REQUIREMENTS

1.	PERMITTED AND NON-PERMITTED PERSONS
1.1.	No person who has symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (this includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, lack of smell or fatigue) is permitted to attend the Circuit or participate in the Activity.
1.2.	Any person who starts to feel unwell or to exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 during the Activity must immediately avoid contact with all persons at the Circuit and MUST IMMEDIATELY LEAVE the Circuit.
1.3.	Essential Persons may be at the Circuit for the purpose of conducting the Activity. Essential Karting Personnel is defined as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Club President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary; and • Grid Marshal / Track Control Official / Clerk of the Course; and • First Aid Attendant; and • Administration and Access Control Attendant/s.
1.4.	Permitted Persons <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Licensed Driver (Driver) in the COVID-19 Restricted Social Karting activity who has booked their entry in the session plus other persons per kart who must be either: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The Parent or Legal Guardian of the Driver; or ○ The Participant License Holder for the Driver; or ○ A Mechanic whose sole task it is, is to prepare, adjust, repair the kart as may be required. • A Person who is approved by the Club to supply karting components and provide specialised karting service to any Permitted Persons in attendance at the Activity.
1.5.	PUBLIC ACCESS and SPECTATORS are permitted to be in attendance. A maximum of 500 persons in total can be in attendance at this event.
1.6.	All Permitted Persons in attendance must be the holder of a Karting Australia Licence. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For the avoidance of doubt, this Licence can be a Drivers, Participant or Pit Crew Licence.
1.7.	A Permitted Person attending the Activity must leave the Circuit as soon as they have completed their driving or as soon as their Session is finished, whichever is the sooner.
2.	SOCIAL DISTANCING AND DENSITY REQUIRMENTS (Note – the numbers chosen in 2.1 <u>must not exceed the maximum number of people permitted to gather under Government Directions.</u>)
2.1.	Government prescribed Social Distancing measures must be observed at all times.
2.2.	Permitted Persons MUST NOT park or set their Pit up within 2 metres of another Permitted Person’s Pit space.
2.3.	The use by Permitted Persons of any indoor facilities (other than toilets and washrooms) is strictly prohibited.
2.4.	If food service is provided, it must comply with government requirements and be take away only. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hand Hygiene must be available at any food service outlet.
3.	KARTING AUSTRALIA COVID-19 DECLARATION
3.1	Under NO circumstances is ANYONE who has been overseas in the previous 14 days or been in contact with a person who is known to be COVID-19 positive, permitted to attend the Circuit. All Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons MUST : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete and submit the Karting Australia COVID-19 Declaration at least 24 hours before the commencement time of the Activity; and • Forward to the Club Activity Co-Ordinator the confirmation email that you receive after submitting the completed COVID-19 Declaration. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If the confirmation email is not sent to the Club on time, you will not be granted access to the Circuit. ○ If you have been overseas in the 14 days before the Activity or if you have been in contact with a Covid-19 Positive person, you will not be granted access to the Circuit.
4.	HYGIENE FACILITIES - TOILET/WASHROOM FACILITIES and HAND SANITISER
4.1	The Club is required to provide facilities to ensure general and sensible hygiene practices are maintained.
4.2	Toilet and washroom facilities at the Circuit must be open and available for use.
4.3	Washroom facilities must be properly equipped with liquid soap, running water and either air hand driers or paper towels. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The toilets and washroom facilities must be cleaned between Sessions or as otherwise required.
4.4	It is strongly recommended that Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons bring their own supply of hand sanitiser for use in accordance with government recommendations.



5.	HYGIENE – NON-SHARING OF EQUIPMENT
5.1	The sharing of any equipment including but not limited to: tools, apparel, safety equipment, pens is not permitted.
