Important Note:

These Supplementary Regulations can only be used for Social Karting activities at Affiliated Clubs in strict accordance with the requirements of all Federal and State Government COVID-19 mass gathering Orders and Directions.

COVID-19 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND VOLUNTARY ACCEPTANCE OF RISK

By entering or participating in this Karting activity/event, all Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons acknowledge that, even with rigorous capacity and control measures that Karting Australia requires the Organising Club to put in place at all Karting Australia sanctioned Karting activities/events, there remains an unquantifiable risk of transmission of viral illness including COVID-19 at a Karting activity/event at this time and you have considered that risk and your own personal circumstances, including any health condition or vulnerability that you may have or that of persons whom you will be in close contact with following your attendance at a Karting activity/event. You acknowledge that, for a small number of people, COVID-19 has very serious health consequences. By attending a Karting activity/event you (and any persons who attend the activity/event with you) acknowledge and accept these obvious risks.

2. ADMINISTRATION

1.	The Club must maintain a register of all persons who enter the Circuit for the activity.
2.	The Age Divisions offered must be in accordance with the <i>Karting Australia Appendix 1 – Kart Fun Sessions.</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cadet 9, Cadet 12 and 4SS Cadet Drivers are permitted on a Track at the same time. • Junior Drivers are not permitted on the Track with any other age division. • Senior Drivers are not permitted on the Track with any other age division.



3.	PRE-ENTRY
3.1.	The number of positions in the Activity is strictly limited by Government Directions/orders. Accordingly, bookings are essential and are accepted strictly on a 'first come first served' basis. The club will have sole rights to change bookings in order to give all members a fair chance of having access to the sessions at the club's discretion. There will be NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED ON THE DAY.
3.2.	Payment of the Entry Fee can only be made by using Credit Card through the Karting Australia CMS
4.	Entry Fee: Free for SCKC Members - \$40.00 per person (non-race entrants of Sapphire Cup who are not members of SCKC) – Entries Close midnight Thursday 12 th November.
4.1.	The Entry Fee for each driver at this activity includes GST.

3. SPECIFIC COVID-19 RESTRICTION AND MITIGATION REQUIREMENTS

	THE CLUB HAS COMPLETED A COVIDSafe ACTION PLAN The Plan has been submitted to Karting Australia NSW and where required by law, to the relevant State Government Department. All actions identified as being required to be done to create a COVIDSafe Event and Club facility must be carried out prior to and during the Event.
1.	PERMITTED AND NON-PERMITTED PERSONS
1.1.	No person who has symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (this includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, lack of smell or fatigue) is permitted to attend the Circuit or participate in the Activity.
1.2.	Any person who starts to feel unwell or to exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 during the Activity must immediately avoid contact with all persons at the Circuit and MUST IMMEDIATELY LEAVE the Circuit.
1.3.	Note – The Organising Club must ensure that the maximum number of people (the combined total of Essential Personnel and Permitted Persons) permitted to gather in total at an Activity and in groups in accordance with State Public Health Authority Orders/Directions/Regulations is not exceeded at any time prior to or during the Activity. Essential Karting Personnel is defined as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Club President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary; and • COVIDSafe Officer • Essential Officials identified in Section 1.6 of these Regulations • First Aid Attendant; and • Administration and Access Control Attendant/s • Operations staff (includes but is not limited to canteen staff, cleaners etc).
1.4.	Permitted Persons <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Licensed Driver (Driver) who has booked their entry in the Activity plus a maximum of three (3) other persons per kart who must be either: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The Parent, Legal Guardian, or family member of the Driver; or ○ The Participant License Holder for the Driver; or ○ A Mechanic whose sole task it is, is to prepare, adjust, repair the kart as may be required; A Person who is approved by the Club to supply karting components and provide specialised karting service to any Permitted Persons in attendance at the Activity.
1.5.	A maximum of 500 persons in total can be in attendance at this event.
2.	SOCIAL DISTANCING AND DENSITY REQUIREMENTS
2.1.	Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons are not permitted to gather in groups greater than 50 while in attendance at the Activity.
2.2.	Government prescribed Social Distancing measures must always be observed.



2.3.	Permitted Persons MUST NOT park or set their Pit up within 2 metres of another Permitted Person's Pit space.
2.4.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The use by Permitted Persons of any indoor facilities (other than toilets and washrooms) is strictly limited by the Density Quotient of the room as included in the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan.
2.5.	<p>Food service provided at the Activity must fully comply with all State Public Health Authority Orders/Directions/Regulations.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hand Hygiene must be available at all food service outlets. Regular cleaning in accordance with the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan MUST be carried out throughout the Activity.

3.	KARTING AUSTRALIA COVID-19 DECLARATION
3.1	<p>Under NO circumstances is ANYONE who has been overseas in the previous 14 days or been in contact with a person who is known to be COVID-19 positive, permitted to attend the Circuit.</p> <p>All Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons MUST:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Click Here to Complete and submit the Karting Australia COVID-19 Declaration to attend Sapphire Coast Kart Club at least 24 hours before the commencement time of the Event. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the Declaration is not completed on time, you may not be granted access to the Circuit. If you have been overseas in the 14 days before the Event or if you have been in contact with a Covid-19 Positive person, you will not be granted access to the Circuit. If you have attended any of the reported case locations listed on the NSW Health website (nsw.gov.au/covid-19/latest-news-and-updates) in the 14 days before the Event you are NOT permitted to attend.
4.	HYGIENE FACILITIES - TOILET/WASHROOM FACILITIES and HAND SANITISER
4.1	The Club is required to provide facilities to ensure general and sensible hygiene practices are maintained.
4.2	Toilet and washroom facilities at the Circuit must be open and available for use.
4.3	<p>Washroom facilities must be properly equipped with liquid soap, running water and either air hand driers or paper towels.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The toilets and washroom facilities must be cleaned between Sessions or as otherwise required.
4.4	It is strongly recommended that Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons bring their own supply of hand sanitiser for use in accordance with government recommendations.
5.	HYGIENE – NON-SHARING OF EQUIPMENT
5.1	The sharing of any equipment including but not limited to: tools, apparel, safety equipment, pens is not permitted.

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5. CIRCUIT SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

1.	KART RETRIEVAL
1.1.	Kart trolleys will be given access to the Track.
1.2.	Retrieval of karts is at the discretion of the Grid / Track Control Official.
1.3.	A person must only enter the Track when permitted by an Official and then only when safe to do so.
2.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
2.1.	No animals allowed anywhere within the facility.
2.2.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
2.3.	No Bicycles, Scooters or Skate Boards.
